

AGC Range Facilities

The AGC owns and operates an 87 acre multiple discipline shooting facility in Marriottsville, MD. The AGC's facilities include:

100 yard range

- 90 covered positions for general use
- 10 covered firing positions for bench rest shooting from permanent benches



50 yard pistol range

- 58 covered firing positions
- Tables for shooters on the firing line
- Rotating target frames for matches

200 yard range – High Power (outdoors)

- 10 covered firing positions
- Long range competition targets



Trap Range

- Four lighted trap fields
- Voice activated automatic throwers
- Wobble trap thrower on field four
- Open to public on Sunday afternoons and Wednesday afternoons & nights
- Two shotgun patterning boards



Air rifle & range – (Indoor & climate controlled)

- 6 indoor firing positions

Archery Range – (outdoor)

- Three positions with target stands
- Elevated platform

Meeting Houses – (Two)

- Heated and Air Conditioned
- Large Halls for meetings and events
- Kitchen, Indoor restroom facilities
- Handicap accessible (Barnes Range)



Events & Programs

Many of the events and programs hosted at the AGC facilities are open to public participation. All events open to the public are available to all law abiding, responsible persons regardless of race, color, creed, sex, or place of national origin. Participation in individual club sponsored events may be limited to the members of the club sponsoring the event.



Public Trap:

The AGC trap range is open to the public on Sunday afternoons from 12-4 pm, Wednesday 12-2:30 pm and Wednesday nights from 6-9 pm. During these times AGC volunteers supervise and operate the trap range for any individuals who wish to shoot. A modest fee is charged for each round of trap.

Hunter Sight-In & MD State Qualification:

For several weekends each fall, the AGC hosts Hunter Sight-In clinics. On these dates the 100 yard range is open to the public for individuals wishing to sight in their firearms. AGC volunteers supervise the clinics and assist with sight-in.

Volunteers administer the Maryland State qualification course for hunters that wish to hunt on certain Maryland state land. A nominal fee is charged for this service. Please check our website or contact the range for specific dates and times.

High Power Instructional Clinics:

Several AGC clubs offer instructional clinics for shooters wishing to learn and develop their abilities within the High Power shooting disciplines or qualify to purchase an M1 rifle through the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP).

Juniors programs:

Several AGC clubs offer instructional and safety clinics for young shooters. These programs are oriented towards junior shooters and their parents. Clinics often include both classroom instruction and live fire training



Women on Target:

The Women on Target program is an NRA sponsored event that is geared towards the growing community of women shooters. The clinics are suitable for novice as well as experienced women shooters.

Competitive Leagues:

The AGC has several competitive shooting leagues that are focused on specific shooting sports. Some of these leagues include:

- High Power Rifle
- Pistol
- Trap shooting
- Black Powder / Muzzle loader
- Juniors air rifle
- 4-H Trap shooting
- Metallic Silhouette

What is the AGC?

The Associated Gun Clubs of Baltimore, Inc. was formed on July 1, 1944 when a number of World War II veterans in the Baltimore area began looking for a place to conduct recreational and competitive shooting. They organized several Baltimore area shooting clubs to form the Associated Gun Clubs of Baltimore or "AGC".



The AGC is a not-for-profit corporation comprised of many individual member clubs. The talents and resources of the individual clubs are combined to provide central Maryland with the facilities and opportunities to participate in the shooting sports.

The mission of the AGC is to:

- Safely operate a shooting range facility that meets the needs of all shooting disciplines.
- Provide hunting and target shooting instruction courses which promote general firearm safety.
- Offer matches, programs, and events to encourage adult and youth participation in the shooting sports.
- Support, encourage, and actively promote the private ownership of firearms for all law abiding citizens.



Membership

To join a member club, contact the club and speak with the club's membership director. For a complete list of the member clubs and club contact information, please visit our website.

Club members are allowed to purchase a range badge.

In order to promote and ensure the safety of our facility and members, each new member is required to complete a range orientation and safety seminar before their range badge is issued.

Members who have purchased range badges are entitled to use the AGC ranges and facilities any time the facility is open. Members who have range badges are entitled to bring guests to shoot with them on the ranges.

Range badges are valid for one calendar year. Junior and Family badges are available at reduced cost.

Range badges cannot be shared or loaned.

Range badges are not required for trap shooting with the general public when the trap range is open to the public. Range badge owners pay a reduced fee during public trap events.

AGC ranges will be on your left at the intersection of Marriottsville Road & Wards Chapel Road

From Liberty Road:

Turn on Marriottsville Rd (South Bound)
Go 3.4 Miles
AGC ranges will be on your right at the intersection of Marriottsville Road & Wards Chapel Road.

Visitors: Check in with the Range Officer at the Lower Range House on the 100 yard range. Use the entrance on Wards Chapel Road
