### **Minutes for November 5, 2017 Annual Meeting**

#### **President's Report:**

- 1) AGC Trustees are voting Tuesday November 7 to remove the Legislative VP (LVP) position from officer in AGC the Bylaws and replace with a committee/chair. Follow-up; Trustees postponed vote until December 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- 2) Member summary: The Homewood Rifle and Pistol Club had 268 active members when we met for the 2017 Annual Meeting. 62 members from 2017 did not renew for 2017 prior to 2018 renewals. We currently have 248 active members; an overall decrease of 7.46%.

#### **Vice President Report:**

#### **Treasurer Report:**

- 1) Balance of Checkbook: Start of fiscal: \$15,475.93, End:\$15,875.15 Diff \$399.22
- 2) Financial records: Submitted in writing
- 3) Tax Status: Forms were submitted for Fiscal 2015. Will be working on this year (Fiscal 2016) taxes soon.
- 4) Certificate of Deposits: Funds in new 12 month CD at rate of 0.10%. Matures on 6/25/2017. Current balance \$6,302.67
- 5) Electronic payments: Still working on establishing some form of electronic payment for member renewal.

#### **Old Business: (summarized by President Dale Walker)**

- 1) Dale did not pursue electronic payments as directed. Trying to figure of logistics so renewal form can accompany payment, as well as limiting the process only to renewing members.
- 2) Equipment: Steel targets (AGC appropriate) and .22 ammo purchased for scout shoots.
- 3) Storage: No updates. AGC has not made any effort to construct small storage facilities for clubs. Maintenance building took a lot of funds and preparation for the area and required permits are prohibitive at this time.
- 4) Apparel: still have inventory but getting low on Patches. Prices: Hats \$10, Tees are \$10 for sizes S through XL, \$12 for XXL & XXXL. \$2.00 Patches & Window clings. Two for \$1.00 HRPC ECI (standard or rim-fire). Polo shirts (black) are \$18 for S through XL and \$20 for XXL. **Prices will remain the same for 2018.**
- 5) Web Hosting: Site Solutions went back to Yahoo Small Business from Aabaco Small Business. There were no issues due to transition.
- 6) Homewood Rifle and Pistol Club renewed as a Civilian Marksmanship Program affiliate. This satisfies one of the requirements for individuals wanting to purchase firearms through the CMP. Full eligibility requirements can be found at <http://www.thecmp.org/eligibility.htm>

- 7) Club Trap Shoot: Had good food from Mission Barbecue for summer shoot. Members provided sides and desserts. Attendance has been low this year.
- 8) Family rate: Family annual dues are 50% of the regular member annual dues. The rate will apply to spouses, children, parents, grandchildren and grandparents of a current primary club member. **Fee to remain unchanged for 2018.**
- 9) New members: Initiation fee is \$10 for all new members. New member received a patch, window cling and four ECI's at the range orientation for the 2017 season. **Unchanged for 2018.**
- 10) HRPC hosted Troop 75. The troops shot steel and stuffed animals on the Barnes Range. HRPC supported the inaugural Youth Summer Trap Program. Youth shot twice per month June, July and August. We had a cookout at the end and provided small gifts for the participants. Thanks to the HRPC all of the members that helped. Currently we have Troop 75 scheduled to use trap 1 and Barnes range on April 27, 2018 so we will need volunteers again.
- 11) The AGC did not progress on secure room in maintenance building for clubs have gun safe. As a result we did not purchase a safe. As stated earlier, construction required a lot of funds.

#### **New Business:**

- 1) Dale requested the purchase of shotguns for scout shoot. After discussion, members authorized the Officers to use between \$2,000-\$3,000 of the clubs funds to purchase two 20 gauge shotguns, two 12 gauge shotguns and a "Pelican" case similar to the ones that the club purchased for rifles. Dale currently purchased a Remington 11-87 youth 20 gauge which has gone through many thousands of rounds with the scouts.
- 2) 200 yard range: Member brought up issue with recent experience while trying to use 200 yard high power range. The HRPC member wanted to use the range but found that the target carriages were locked with combination locks and could not be used. Member requested RSO to unlock the carriages but RSO did not have combination for 8 of the 10 positions. AGC is only allowing two positions ( # 1 and 2) for the use of non-high-power team members. The other 8 positions can be used, but badge holders will need use their own frames/targets. John is in communication with the AGC officers. To date, this issue is unresolved.
