

# Homewood Rifle and Pistol Club Incorporated (HRPC) A Charter Club in the Associated Gun Clubs of Baltimore December 3, 2018

## General Information and Prerequisites

The club meets once a year on the First Sunday in November. We have a dinner starting at 6:00 pm prior to the meeting which begins at 7:00 pm in Memorial Hall on the AGC Trap Range.

Prospective members must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Minimum 16 years old
- 2) Member of the National Rifle Association. NRA application is available on line at <http://www.nrahq.org> or from our club if needed.
- 3) Have sponsorship from a current Homewood R&P member. Note; sponsorship is available from a Homewood officer after successfully completing a "Range and Safety Orientation" with an officer
- 4) Attend AGC Range and Safety Orientation (see below for details)
- 5) Sign AGC affidavit to abide to all rules, regulations and policies
- 6) Present a valid photo ID.

## Membership Fees for Homewood Rifle and Pistol Club *HRPC accepts payment of cash and check.*

**Annual HRPC Dues:** \$20 (\$10 Family member: This rate applies to spouses, children, parents, grandchildren and grandparents of a current primary club member.)

**HRPC Initiation Fee:** \$10 (a onetime fee that applies to primary and family membership).

## AGC Range Badge Fees and Processing Annual AGC *Payment of cash, credit, online prepayment or check accepted by AGC.*

**2019 Range Badge:** \$190 (\$95 after July 1st for new member).

**Annual AGC Family member Badge:** \$63. A child under age 23 still living at home or a spouse of a regular adult AGC badge holder qualifies to purchase a range badge at the family member rate. Payment of cash or check is accepted by AGC.

NOTE: Range badges are typically processed on Monday through Friday 10:15 am until 2:30 pm, and alternating Saturday/Sunday from 9:30 am until 2:30 pm, but times vary. ## Orientation Location:

Orientations start in the LOWER CLASSROOM of the Barnes Range House on the property of the AGC. See map below.

## **Orientation Description**

The orientation usually takes about 1.5 to 2 hours. It consists of a video presentation, Question and Answer session and a walking tour of the AGC facility. You will be required to read and sign the AGC affidavit, provide picture identification, complete the HRPC application, provide an NRA member number (or complete NRA application if not already a member) and pay the applicable fees. When completed, you will be issued a Homewood Rifle and Pistol Club member card, HRPC patch, HRPC window cling, and an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI).

## **Directions to AGC**

The orientation starts in the lower classroom of the Barnes Range House on the property of the AGC. Directions to the AGC and Orientation: The Barnes Range house is accessible from Wards Chapel Road (the road just past "AGC Lane" on Marriottsville Road when coming from Interstate 70.)
